SUBJECT: Agenda Item – Prairie Avenue Mitigation

At the request of the Bayshore Homeowners Association, please place on the agenda of the November Commission Meeting a status update from the administration regarding the Prairie Avenue Mitigation measures that the Commission approved at the March 2007 meeting which include the following:

- Enforcement signs and surveillance that the drop off is used correctly and not abused after hours
- The landscaping along the swale next to the roadway needed to prevent vehicles from parking in the swale
- Continue the repaving of Prairie Avenue until 28<sup>th</sup> Street
- The narrowing of the intersection at Dade Boulevard and Prairie Avenues and the landscape island/welcome sign
- The gate to the school parking for special events off of Dade Boulevard
- The Areca palms along the Par 3 chain link fence to screen cars, etc.
- The promised trees along the swale

Members of the Bayshore HOA would like to attend the Commission Meeting to voice their frustration with the slow progress in implementing these mitigation measures.
