Be it hereby resolved that the board of directors of the Orchard Park Neighborhood Association, acting on behalf of the association's members, approves the creation of an organic community garden in the abandoned canine training area in Pine Tree Park and requests the City to work with OPNA liaison Tobi Ash and her community garden committee to establish a garden this year. The OPNA board believes that in keeping with the designation of the park as a nature preserve, the garden must be an organic garden, free of toxic pesticides and herbicides.
