



MANHOLE MAINTENANCE

Permit Application Checklist

DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED WITH MANHOLE APPLICATION

- Four (4) sets of site plan, drawn to scale, with 11"X17" as minimum paper size, identifying property lines;
- Copy of Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) *approved* Permit package for roadway/lane closure for State roadways and right-of-ways;
- Certified Maintenance of Traffic Plan (MOT);
- Copy of Dewatering Permit and DERM Permit;

OTHER DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED DURING THIS PROCESS

- Copy of Right of Way Permit and Plan on Job Site at all times during construction;

MINIMUM CONSTRUCTION STANDARDS FOR THIS PROJECT

- Construction allowed in the Right-Of-Way only between 9:00 am-4:00 pm;
- The applicant must call the Miami Beach Public Works Department (305) 673-7080 or (305) 673-7625 (24 hour staffed control room) for after-hours emergencies and/or for providing manhole location prior to occupying Right-of-Way.
- Provide hay bales or approved infiltration device at storm water inlet during manhole dewatering operation.
