### NO BUTTS ON THE BEACH

Miami Beach Commissioner Jerry Libbin is on a crusade against litter. "This is really a quality of life issue," said Libbin, who plans to crack down on scofflaws this month with the help of volunteers stationed at key entrance points to the beach.

"The first weekend they will greet visitors, tell them to enjoy the beach, but also remind them that Miami Beach does not allow glass or bottles and please don't leave cigarette butts in the sand," Libbin said.

"The second weekend they will do the same thing, but I hope to have code enforcement out there handing out written warnings." Libbin said the warning could lead to fines.

"If you have laws, and don't enforce them, then what is the use of having them in the first place? This is not about banning smoking on the beach, this is about litter and keeping our beaches clean."
