Each board, commission, or agency of this state or of any political subdivision thereof shall include in the notice of any meeting or hearing, if notice of the meeting or hearing is required, of each board, commission, or agency, conspicuously on such notice, the advice that, if a person desires to appear and question made by the person, question or submission with respect to any matter considered at such meeting or hearing, he or she will need a record of the proceedings, and that, for such purpose, he or she may need to arrange for a verbatim record of the proceedings, if made, which record includes the testimony and questions upon which the appeal is to be based. The requirements of this section do not apply to the notices provided in s. 200.06(2)(c).
