#### **Miami Beach Events at Public Venues**

Free Fireworks on the beach at 8<sup>th</sup> Street at Midnight on New Years.

#### **Traffic & Parking Restrictions**

Ocean Drive will be open to pedestrians only from Thursday, December 31, 2009 at 7:00 a.m. to Sunday, January 3, 2010 at 7:00 a.m. in anticipation of large crowds during the holiday weekend.

The 100 Block from Sixth to 14 streets will be closed from Ocean Court (alley) to Ocean Drive

#### **Free Transportation: The South Beach Local**

Miami-Dade Transit's South Beach Local will be free of charge to riders on New Years Eve. The South Beach Local will operate on its normal route on Thursday, December 31, 2009, with extended hours from 8:00 a.m. December 31, 2009 until 7:00 a.m., Friday, January 1, 2010. Normal service will resume on Friday, January 1, at 10:00 a.m. with the usual fare of 25 cents.

#### **Parking**

- All city-owned parking lots and garages will have normal operations (open: 24/7).
- Residential parking zones citywide will be enforced.
- Valet operations normally on Ocean Drive will be relocated to Collins Avenue.

#### **Extended Hours**

Some nightclubs will have extended hours on New Years Eve until 7:00 a.m. on January 1, 2010.

#### **Offices Closed**

City of Miami Beach administrative offices will be closed Friday, January 1, 2010.
