Subject: **HURRICANE SEASON June 1st through November 30, 2010.**

Attached is the 2010 Hurricane Preparedness Information provided by the City of Miami Beach to assist you and your guests during the upcoming hurricane season, which starts June 1st. Please distribute this information to your **staff** and keep copies handy for distribution to your **guests** in the case of a hurricane watch and/or mandatory evacuation of Miami Beach during the hurricane season. Do not discard this information as it will serve as a guide for you and your guests during hurricane emergencies.

You have received the Hotel Emergency Information Sheet for updating your hotel property's information. **It is your responsibility to update this information and return it to the City of Miami Beach whenever there is a change.** This information is of the utmost importance during hurricane season when there may be the need to contact you regarding information vital to the safety of you and your guests. All communications will be sent to you using the information provided on your Hotel Emergency Information Sheet.

The **Tourist Hurricane Hotline at (305) 468-5900** provides visitors with information on hotel room availability outside the evacuation zone, ground transportation, updates on the airport and seaport and responds to visitor inquires 24-hours a day during hurricane watches and evacuations. The tourist Hurricane Hotline is **activated when a hurricane watch is issued** from the Emergency Operations Center (EOC).

IF YOU HAVE NOT UPDATED YOUR PROPERTY'S EMERGENCY INFORMATION, PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU MAKE THE NECESSARY CHANGES AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.

PREPARING FOR A HURRICANE
INFORMATION YOU NEED TO KNOW
HURRICANE SEASON 2010**

The key to survival is planning. Formulate your plan of action **now**. Since Miami Beach is a designated evacuation zone for hurricanes, **having a plan is vital.**

The National Weather Service has increased their lead times for Hurricane Watches and Warnings. Watches will now be issued 48 hours in advance and Warnings will now be issued 36 hours in advance.

When a Mandatory Evacuation is ordered, please inform your guests that they must evacuate Miami Beach and go to an inland hotel (see list provided) or leave by train, car, bus or air.

URGENT TO READ:

June 1, through November 30, 2010, is the time to carefully prepare or review your hotel Hurricane Preparedness Plan for 2010. Providing for the safety, comfort and peace of mind of our hotel guests is an important part of a Hurricane Preparedness Plan. As you begin this process, it is important to remember that during a hurricane emergency, each hotel is responsible for helping provide its guests with information and options to assist them in making knowledgeable decisions before a mandatory evacuation is ordered. **Also, it is the responsibility of the hotel to help provide its guests with transportation and alternate accommodations during a hurricane evacuation.**

It is the responsibility of all hotels located on Miami Beach, which is a Miami-Dade County evacuation zone, to inform their guests of the dangers posed by a hurricane and hotel management should help make proper arrangements to move their guests to safety. A prudent option is for management to arrange private ground transportation for their guests to sister properties located in non-evacuation zones. If the hotel does not have a sister property located on the mainland, it is strongly encouraged that the hotel management help make hurricane arrangements with a mainland hotel before the hurricane season gets underway. These arrangements should be made **before** a hurricane is eminent. The attached lists have been prepared as a resource to assist you in securing hotel reservations and transportation, for your guests.

Out-of-town visitors and house guests depend on you for advice and guidance during a weather emergency, especially during hurricane season. When it is determined that a hurricane will impact our community, out-of-town visitors are encouraged to alter their travel plans and depart the destination prior to the arrival of the storm. However, guests that are unable to depart should be included in your hurricane preparedness plans. For more information on assisting visitors during hurricane emergencies, visit Miami-Dade County's website or call 3-1-1.

As part of the government's emergency planning, the American Red Cross, in cooperation with Miami-Dade County Office of Emergency Management, will open evacuation shelters throughout Miami-Dade County for **evacuated residents**. Hotel management on Miami Beach should not consider sending their guests to a Red Cross evacuation shelter. **Only after all efforts to find accommodations outside the evacuation zone have failed should hotel guests be directed to Red Cross evacuation shelters.**

An evacuation shelter is a haven of last resort and can only promise refuge from the storm. Shelters are crowded, uncomfortable, and provide mere essentials and restroom facilities. If you must refer your guests to a Red Cross evacuation shelter, it is strongly recommended that you send staff members to accompany your guests.

Also, as a last resort, if you need to use public pick-up sites and emergency shelters, the information will be faxed and e-mailed to you as soon as the locations and schedules are determined.

HURRICANE SEASON 2010
JUNE 1st THROUGH NOVEMBER 30th, 2010
HELPFUL INFORMATION

I am on Miami Beach. How do I formulate a hurricane plan?

- Meet with your hotel guests and discuss what you will do before and after the hurricane.
- Radio and television will inform Miami Beach tourists if there is a need to evacuate. Television channels 4, 5, 6, 7, 10, (23 & 51 in Spanish) as well as most radio stations will be airing special Public Service Announcements about Miami Beach.
- Stay inland at a low-rise inland hotel.
- Leave early to avoid heavy traffic and roads that may become blocked by flood waters.
- Consider the needs of the elderly to leave early.
- Prepare an emergency phone list, and determine how your family will remain in contact if separated during the hurricane.
- Select meeting places and choose an out-of-state or out-of-country friend or relative as a check-in contact to call.
- Rehearse your hurricane plan so that everyone will remember what to do.

What emergency supplies should I include in my hurricane kit?

In case of an evacuation, it is a good idea to prepare a hurricane kit to take with you that includes the following:

- A first aid kit that includes **prescription medications**.
- Food that will not spoil and a three to five day supply of water (one gallon per person per day is suggested), eating utensils, and a manual can opener.
- Battery-powered radio, flashlight and plenty of batteries.
- One change of clothing including shoes.
- Sanitation items, such as toilet tissue and towelettes.
- Cash, credit cards, airline tickets, passports, an extra set of car keys, and all valuables.
- Special items for infants, the elderly, or the disabled.
- An extra pair of eyeglasses.

Remember:

Your hurricane supplies should be stored in easy-to-carry containers such as coolers or backpacks.

Other preparations:

Make copies of all important documents and store them in watertight containers. Keep one set of copies with you and send an extra set to an out-of-state or out-of-country friend or relative. **(Tourist Hurricane Hotline: 305 468-5900)**.

Staying with a friend is always best. If this is not possible, then check with the Hotel regarding arrangements they can make on your behalf.

The City of Miami Beach will send an e-mail to your property, as soon as a Mandatory Evacuation Order Notice is issued.

La clave de la supervivencia es la **planificación**. Prepare **ahora** su plan de acción. **Tener un plan es vital**.

El Servicio Meteorológico Nacional ha adelantado el tiempo para la notificación de aviso de las Advertencias y los Avisos de Huracanes. Los Avisos ahora serán publicados con 48 horas de antelación y las Advertencias ahora serán publicadas con 36 horas de anticipación.

Cuando se ordena una Evacuación Mandatoria, favor de informarle a sus huéspedes que deben salir de Miami Beach e ir a un hotel de tierra firme (ver lista adjunta) o salir vía tren, bus, auto o por aire.

INFORMACION IMPORTANTE:

Desde el 1ro de junio hasta el 30 de noviembre de 2010, es el momento para prepararse y revisar cuidadosamente su Plan de Preparación para la Temporada de Huracanes del 2010. Es importante el tener en cuenta la seguridad, la comodidad y la paz mental de nuestros huéspedes en los hoteles y el Plan de Preparación para la Temporada de Huracanes es una parte muy importante. Al comenzar este proceso, es importante recordar que durante una emergencia de huracán, cada hotel es responsable de proveer a sus huéspedes con la información y las opciones para ayudarlos a tomar decisiones adecuadas antes de que se ordene la evacuación mandatoria. **También es la responsabilidad del hotel de a proveer a sus huéspedes con el transporte y hospedaje alterno durante la evacuación durante un huracán.**

Es responsabilidad de todos los hoteles ubicados en Miami Beach, que es una zona de evacuación del Condado de Miami-Dade, de informarle a sus huéspedes acerca del peligro que representa un huracán y la gerencia del hotel deberá hacer arreglos pertinentes para movilizar a sus huéspedes a un área segura. Una opción aconsejable es que la gerencia tenga disponible transporte terrestre privado para trasladar a sus huéspedes a una propiedad de la misma cadena o cualquier otra propiedad localizada en una de las zonas de no evacuación. Si el hotel no tiene una propiedad de su misma cadena en tierra firme, se le recomienda enfáticamente a la gerencia del hotel que haga sus arreglos de huracán con un hotel en tierra firme antes de que la temporada de huracanes comience. Estos arreglos deberán hacerse **antes** de la llegada inminente del huracán. La lista adjunta ha sido preparada para que puedan hacer reservaciones y provean a sus huéspedes con hoteles, y transportación para sus huéspedes.

Como parte del plan de emergencia gubernamental, la Cruz Roja Americana, en cooperación con la Oficina de Emergencia del Condado de Miami-Dade, abrirá sus refugios de evacuación a través del Condado de Miami-Dade para albergar a los residentes en sus refugios. La administración hotelera en Miami Beach no deberá considerar el enviar a sus huéspedes a la Cruz Roja o a un refugio de evacuación. **Solamente después de haber agotado todos los recursos para alojar a sus huéspedes en hoteles fuera de la zona de evacuación, deberá el hotel dirigir a sus huéspedes a la Cruz Roja o a un refugio de evacuación.**

Un refugio de evacuación se debe utilizar en caso de última instancia, y solo proveen refugio de la tormenta. Los refugios de evacuación se llenan, son incómodos y sólo proveen lo más necesario y las facilidades higiénicas son precarias. Si usted tiene que enviar a uno de sus huéspedes a la Cruz Roja o alguno de estos refugios, se les recomienda enfáticamente que envíe a un miembro de su personal para que atienda a sus huéspedes.

Como último recurso, si necesitan usar transporte y refugio para sus huéspedes, la información de los puntos de recogida se les enviará vía correo electrónico tan pronto la tengamos disponible.

SUGERENCIAS

Yo me encuentro en Miami Beach, cómo preparo un plan para huracanes?

- * Reúnase con los huéspedes de su hotel y discuta lo que debe hacer antes y después del huracán.
- * La necesidad de evacuar se le transmitirá a los turistas de Miami Beach a través de la radio y la televisión. Los canales de televisión 23 y 51 (en español) y 4, 5, 6, 7, y 10 (en inglés) transmitirán **Anuncios de Servicio Público** especiales, acerca de Miami Beach.
- * Manténgase tierra adentro en un hotel tierra adentro de baja elevación.
- * Salga con tiempo suficiente para evitar el alto volumen de tráfico y los caminos que puedan estar bloqueados por inundaciones.
- * Tome en cuenta las necesidades de las personas muy mayores para que evacuen temprano.
- * Prepare una lista de teléfonos de emergencia y determine cómo se mantendrá en contacto su familia en el caso de que se separen durante el huracán.
- * Seleccione lugares de reunión y escoja un amigo o pariente fuera del estado como punto de contacto para llamadas.
- * Practique su plan de huracanes de manera que todos recuerden lo que deben hacer.

Qué artículos de emergencia debo incluir en mi equipo para huracanes?

- Es una buena idea tener preparado un equipo para huracanes que usted pueda llevar consigo si ocurre una evacuación. El mismo debe incluir lo siguiente:
- * Un equipo de primeros auxilios que incluya medicinas que hayan sido recetadas.
 - * Comida que no sea propensa a dañarse y agua suficiente para tres a cinco días (se recomienda un galón de agua por persona por día), utensilios para comer y un abridor de latas de mano.
 - * Un radio de baterías, una linterna, y suficientes baterías.
 - * Un cambio de ropa, que incluya zapatos.
 - * Artículos sanitarios, tal como papel sanitario o toallas.
 - * Dinero en efectivo, tarjetas de crédito, boletos de avión, pasaportes, copias adicionales de las llaves del automóvil, y cualquier artículo de valor.
 - * Artículos especiales para los infantes, las personas muy mayores, o las personas con limitaciones físicas.
 - * Un par adicional de espejuelos o lentes.

Recuerde:

- * Debe guardar sus artículos para huracán en recipientes fáciles de cargar, tales como recipientes cubiertos, neveras portátiles, o mochilas.

Preparativos Adicionales:

- * Haga copias de todos sus documentos importantes y guárdelos en recipientes a prueba de agua. Quédese con una de las copias y envíe otra a un amigo o pariente fuera del estado o el país.

Siempre es mejor quedarse con un amigo. De ésto no ser posible, entonces deberá comunicarse con su Hotel para que ellos le informen cuales son los arreglos necesarios que ellos podrían hacer por usted.

La Ciudad de Miami Beach le enviará por correo electrónico tan pronto este disponible una Orden de Evacuación Mandatoria.

SAFETY TIPS

1. Watch your luggage at the Airport, during hotel check-in and checkout and at all times. Don't answer the door in a hotel room without verifying who it is. If a person claims to be an employee, call the front desk and ask if someone from their staff is supposed to have access to your room and for what purpose.
2. When returning to your hotel late in the evening, use the main entrance of the hotel. Be observant and look around before entering parking lots.
3. Close the door securely whenever you are in your room and use all of the locking devices provided.
4. Don't needlessly display guest room keys in public or carelessly leave them on restaurant tables, at the swimming pool, or other places where they can be easily stolen.
5. Do not draw attention to yourself by displaying large amounts of cash or expensive jewelry.
6. Don't invite strangers to your room.
7. Place all valuables in the hotel safe deposit box.
8. Do not leave valuables exposed inside of parked car or in the trunk. Do not stop at a public parking lot to go to the beach and leave valuables in plain sight. If you need to put something in your trunk, do it before you arrive at your destination.
9. Check to see that any sliding glass doors or windows and any connecting room doors are locked.
10. If you see any suspicious activity, please report your observations to the management.
11. Be careful and aware at all times and do not leave your personal belongings, such as a purse or cameras slung on back of chairs, especially be aware in restaurants, pool areas and open air cafes.
12. When you go for a swim at the beach or at a pool, don't leave your personal belongings unattended.
