SUBJECT: TPC Motions

Dear Mayor and Honorable City Commission:

The Transportation and Parking Committee met on June 7, 2010 and passed several motions regarding the below discussion items:

**Hybrid Parking Amendments to Incentives:**

The Transportation and Parking Committee passed motion to keep dedicated spaces at 1% at the 42<sup>nd</sup> Street Garage and once capacity hits, move up to 1.5% and then 2%, etc.

The Committee also passed motion to cap incentive at 5%, triggering an automatic review of policy.

**Parking Violations Fee Schedule Amendments:**

Committee passed motion that parking violations fees should be increased as follows:

- Overtime: \$23
- Restricted: \$30
- Prohibited: \$30

**Parking Event Flat Rate Amendments:**

Committee passed motion to limit the City Manager's discretion to surface lots only; fee to be \$6 for residents and \$18 for visitors or option to use iPark device on a per hour basis; signage and employees to advise anyone entering, what three (3) options are.
