Victim Surprises Burglars

On 09/28/11, the victim, Nanci Koones, returned to her home located at 3463 Royal Palm Ave, Miami Beach, FL and discovered an unknown occupied green GMC Jimmy in her driveway. Ms. Koones engaged the driver in a conversation; however, quickly noticed a second subject exiting her home. Realizing she had just confronted burglars, Ms. Koones called the police and provided a description of the subjects and their vehicle.

MBPD Officers quickly saturated the area and the fleeing vehicle was stopped in the 1500 Blk of Alton Rd. Two of three subjects were immediately apprehended; the third fled on foot and was apprehended shortly thereafter.

Ms. Koones positively identified two of the three subjects. The subjects had in their possession items belonging to Ms. Koones. The investigation revealed other personnel affects staged outside of a door at the incident location, which had been pried open.

Post Miranda, Detectives were able to obtain a confession as well as identify a second burglary committed earlier in the day at 424 W. 26 Street, Miami Beach, FL.
