Miami Beach Public Events

- Fireworks on the beach at 8 Street at midnight on New Years. Free.
- Orange Drive Music Festival, December 30, 2011 – January 2, 2012, Ocean Drive beach, between 7 – 9 streets. Ticketed event. www.orangedr.com

Traffic & Parking Restrictions

Ocean Drive (5 to 14 streets) will be open to pedestrians only (no vehicles) from Friday, December 30 at 7:00 a.m. through Monday, January 2, 2012 at 7:00 a.m. in anticipation of large crowds during the holiday weekend.

The 100 Block from Sixth to 14 streets will be closed from Ocean Court (alley) to Ocean Drive and eastbound 10 Street will be closed from Collins to Ocean Court.

Parking

- All municipally operated parking facilities will be open. The following lots will have extended hours until 4:00 a.m. on December 31/January 1: 46 Street, South Pointe Park, Convention Center & Fillmore. Special event flat rates (\$15 - \$20) may apply at most garages during holidays and weekends.
- Residential parking zones citywide will be enforced.
- Valet operations normally on Ocean Drive will be relocated to Collins Avenue.

Extended Hours

Some nightclubs will have extended hours until 7:00 a.m. on Sunday, January 1, 2012 and Monday, January 2, 2012.

Tips to Enjoy the Weekend

- No open alcoholic beverages in public.
- No glass containers on the beach.
- Do not litter; recycle when possible.
- Walk on sidewalks and designated pedestrian areas.
- Keep noise to a minimum.
