ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1605. THE UNCLASSIFIED EMPLOYEES SALARY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA (THE "ORDINANCE"), BY AMENDING THE SALARY RANGES AND ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION PROVISIONS FOR THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR REPEALER, SEVERABILITY, CODIFICATION, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission wish to amend the City's Unclassified Salary Ordinance to establish certain compensation categories for the City Manager and City Attorney.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 1605, the Unclassified Employees Salary Ordinance, is hereby amended as follows:
