To request this material in accessible format, sign language interpreters, information on access for persons with disabilities, and/or any accommodation to review any document, or participate in any city-sponsored proceeding, please contact 305-673-7411 (voice), 305-673-7254 (fax) or 711 (TTY; FL Relay Service) five days in advance to initiate your request. A meeting not noticed in the Weekly Meeting Notice ad and determined to be an emergency meeting will be posted on the bulletin boards throughout City Hall and will be available on the City's website at web.miamibeachfl.gov/cityclerk/.

Fla. Statute 286.0105 Notices of meetings and hearings must advise that a record is required to appeal. Each board, commission, or agency of this state or of any political subdivision thereof shall include in the notice of such meeting or hearing, if notice of the meeting or hearing is required, of such board, commission, or agency, conspicuously on such notice, the advice that, if a person decides to appeal any decision made by the board, agency, or commission with respect to any matter considered at such meeting or hearing, he or she will need a record of the proceedings, and that, for such purpose, he or she may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based. The requirements of this section do not apply to the notice provided in s. 200.065(3).
