State Road (SR) SR 907/Alton Road from 5 Street to Michigan Avenue

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six is developing the design for a roadway project along SR 907 / Alton Road, in the City of Miami Beach, Miami-Dade County.

SR 907/Alton Road from 5 Street to Michigan Avenue **Project identification number: 249911-1-52-01**

- Reconstructing the road
- Installing new lighting, signs and pavement markings
- Installing new drainage and inlets
- Installing new landscaping
- Reconstructing driveways at their existing locations
- Rebuilding pedestrian ramps and reconstructing sidewalks
- Parking removal (about 90 parking spaces will be removed to accommodate sidewalk extensions).
- Adding sidewalk extensions (bulb-outs) at all intersections
- Upgrading pedestrian ramps and installing push button countdown signals at all intersections
- Installing new mast arm signals at all signalized intersections
- Upgrading the traffic barrier on the flyover and the bridge over Dade Canal
- Modifying the median opening at the intersection of 6 Street and Alton Road to prevent the eastbound left turn movement from 6 Street onto northbound Alton Road to improve safety
- Constructing concrete islands at 9 Street, 13 Street, 14 Court, and 15 Terrace

SR 907/Alton Road at 5 Street, 10 Street and 14 Street **Project identification number: 249911-3-52-01**

- Reconstructing the road
- Installing new lighting, signs and pavement markings
- Installing new drainage and inlets
- Installing new mast arm signals and pedestrian signals
- Removing parking spaces at all three intersections to accommodate sidewalk extensions (bulb outs)
- Constructing a concrete island at 14 Street
- Rebuilding pedestrian ramps and sidewalks at all three intersections

PROJECT DATES

Construction is expected to begin in April 2013 and last about 28 months.

ESTIMATED CONSTRUCTION COST

\$27.5 million

POSSIBLE EFFECTS DURING CONSTRUCTION

Temporary road, lanes and sidewalk closures during non-rush hours.

MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC

Work will be done in phases to reduce the effects of construction on the community. Road closures and detours are anticipated during the construction phase of this project. The detour routes will be clearly indicated with directional signs.
