The purpose of this LTC is to announce that the City of Miami Beach Community Outreach Team is coordinating the City's participation in the Annual International Coastal Cleanup Day/Miami-Dade Coastal Cleanup to be held on Saturday, September 21, 2013.

During this event, thousands of volunteers will spend their morning collecting millions of pounds of litter and debris on inland roadsides, along coastal areas, inland lakes and rivers worldwide.

Fourteen volunteer projects will be held in Miami Beach on September 21, 2013 from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. The full length of beach along Miami Beach will be included in the event as well as parks and waterways.
