NOTICE OF CITY COMMISSION MEETING**

NOTICE IS HEREBY given that the City Commission of the City of Miami Beach, Florida, will hold a City Commission Meeting on **Tuesday, November 12, 2013, at 12:00 noon**, in the Commission Chambers, Third Floor, City Hall, 1700 Convention Center Drive, Miami Beach, Florida, for the purpose of canvassing the returns of the November 5, 2013 General and Special Elections and ascertaining the results thereof. Should no Run-Off Election be necessary, new officers shall be declared elected subsequent to canvass of the final General Election returns, at which time the new officers shall be installed and shall enter upon the discharge of their duties. If a Run-Off Election is necessary, all new officers shall be declared elected subsequent to canvass of final Run-Off Election returns on the first business day immediately following the County Elections Supervisor's issuance of such final election results, at which time the new officers shall be installed and shall enter upon the discharge of their duties.

If a Run-Off Election is necessary, the Commission Meeting of November 12, 2013 shall occur for the limited purpose of canvassing the returns of the November 5, 2013 General and Special Elections, and/or to address any emergency matter(s), pursuant to Florida Statute §952.38 (as amended from time to time) and City Charter §2.05.

INTERESTED PARTIES are invited to appear at this meeting, or be represented by an agent, or to express their views in writing addressed to the City Commission, c/o the City Clerk, 1700 Convention Center Drive, 1st Floor, City Hall, Miami Beach, Florida 33139. This meeting may be continued, and under such circumstances, additional legal notice will not be provided.
