A meeting of the Flooding Mitigation Committee has been scheduled for January 28, 2014 at 4:30 PM in the City Manager's Large Conference Room.

1) Discussion Delineating Potential Concerns On Two Future Roadway Projects To Be Undertaken By The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) Along Alton Road; from Michigan Avenue To 43rd Street and From 43rd Street TO East of Allison Road; And Urging FDOT to Ensure That All Community Concerns, Including, But Not Limited To, Loss Of On-Street Parking, Impacts To Mature Shade Trees, And Appropriate Bicycle Facilities, Are Properly Addressed As Part Of The Respective Future Alton Road Projects.

- a. Alton Road from Fifth St. to Michigan Ave. is schedule to be completed in the summer of 2015.**

This project is in the West Ave and Flamingo Park neighborhood.

Current Projects:

- 8th Street and West Ave, tidal mitigation project. This project is out to bid, all work to be completed by 1 Oct 2014
- 11th Street and West Ave, tidal mitigation project. This project is out to bid, all work to be completed by 1 Oct 2014
- Pump stations at 6th St., 10th St. and 14th St. to be construction by FDOT contractor Bergeron. Construction to start 1 May 2014 West Ave. Neighborhood Improvements will be water, sewer, drainage, roadway, landscaping, sidewalk and lighting. This work is schedule to start in the summer of 2015.
- 6th St. drainage improvements to install new drainage improvement includeing a stormwater pump station. This project is scheduled to start 2013/14 but has to be postponed due to Alton Road construction till Summer of 2015

- b. Alton Road from Michigan Ave to 43rd Street is a milling resurfacing project with limited drainage improvements. This project is scheduled to start 1 March 2017 to 1 October 2017.**

This project is in the Bayshore Neighborhood.

Current Projects:

- Lower North Bay Road, including two pump stations

- c. Alton Road from 43rd St. to Allison Road is a complete reconstruction 1 October 2017 to 28 December 2018.**

This project is in the La Gorce Neighborhood.

Current Projects:

- La Gorce Neighborhood Improvement-Propose work will be the relocation of a 20" Water Main from FDOT ROW to City ROW on West Ave. Work to included drainage improvements, landscaping,

lighting, sidewalks and crosswalks, water and sewer. The City drainage design is to install three stormwater pump station. Construction to start in 2014/15

- The City is currently working with FDOT on a Joint Participation Agreement (JPA) with FDOT for the separation of the FDOT storm water drainage and the City's storm water drainage at 59th Street. This joint construction project is scheduled in the Fall of 2014
- Tidal mitigation project at W. 52nd St. and North Bay Road, This project is out to bid, construction to be completed by 1 October 2014

2) Discussion Regarding Flooding At Royal Palm Avenue And 46th Street, Miami Beach.

This project is in the Nautilus Neighborhood.
Current Projects:

- a. Tidal Mitigation project 44th St. and Post Ave A Royal Palm Avenue Intersections, This project is out to bid, construction to be completed by 1 October 2014
- b. Tidal Mitigation project 47th Street & Royal Palm Avenue, This project is out to bid, construction to be completed by 1 October 2014
- c. Tidal Mitigation project Post Ave 43rd Street to 46th Street in Design. This project will be added to the current bid as additional work. To be completed by October 2014
