SUBJECT: **DOG BEACH OPENING**

The purpose of this Letter to Commission (LTC) is to provide information regarding the opening of the City's first Dog Beach.

The Dog Beach will officially open to the public on Friday, June 20, 2014 and will be located at North Shore Open Space Park on Collins Avenue between 80th and 82nd Street. The Dog Beach will be open on Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays from 3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Daily passes may be purchased on-site during Dog Beach hours and annual passes are available at either Normandy Isle Pool or Flamingo Park Pool, seven days a week from 8:00 am – 7:00 pm.

The daily rate for residents is \$5.00 and non-residents are \$25.00. Residents may purchase a trial pass valid through September 2014 for \$20.00. Proof of residency will be required.

Dogs must have collar with rabies tag on at all times.

The Parks & Recreation Department will provide the Mayor and Commission a full detailed report within six months of the opening date.
